1. PURPOSE OF DECLARATION - A declaration for Dunkirk Village Income Tax purposes must be made by all resident Dunkirk Village taxpayers receiving taxable income from which Village Income Tax will not be withheld by an employer for the full amount of 1% gross earnings.
The rationale of the declaration is to enable such taxpayers to estimate their taxable income and to provide a basis for paying currently any Dunkirk Village Income Tax due.

2. WHEN TO FILE A DECLARATION - The declaration must be filed on or before April 30 of the year the estimated payments will be made. (example: for TY17, a declaration must be filed by April 30, 2016)
