IMPORTANT NOTICE:

THIS FORM IS FOR FIGURING YOUR "OTHER CITY EXEMPTION CREDIT" WHEN WITHHOLDING IS HELD IN THE CITY WHERE YOU WORKED. IF YOUR EMPLOYER DID NOT WITHHOLD FOR DUNKIRK, OR YOUR EMPLOYER PROVIDED COURTESY WITHHOLDING FOR THE FULL ONE PERCENT (1%), YOU CAN SIMPLY FILL IN THE BLANKS AND FIND YOUR PROPER EXEMPTION. **IF, HOWEVER, YOUR EMPLOYER PROVIDED COURTESY WITHHOLDING FOR THE PROPER ONE HALF PERCENT (.5%) THEN YOU CANNOT INCLUDE THAT INCOME ON THIS WORKSHEET AS THEY HAVE ALREADY PERFORMED THE EXEMPTION FOR YOU.**

**** IT IS NOT ALWAYS CORRECT TO DIVIDE THE TAXES PAID TO ANOTHER CITY IN HALF BECAUSE NOT ALL CITIES HAVE THE SAME TAX RATE SO HALF OF WHAT IS WITHHELD IS NOT .5% OF THOSE WAGES**

i.e. example 1 above - half of a city withholding 1.5% is .75%, would underpay to Dunkirk

example 2 above - half of a cith withhold .75% is .38%, would overpay to Dunkirk
