



ORDINANCE NO. 2009-11

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE REGULATIONS FOR PAYMENT OF “FINDER’S FEES” FOR GRANTS OBTAINED FOR THE VILLAGE OF DUNKIRK, OHIO AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

WHEREAS, the Village Council has previously passed an ordinance regarding the payment of “finder’s fees” for grants obtained for the good of the Village and/or its residents, and

WHEREAS, the Village Council has deemed it necessary to modify and clarify said regulations, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF DUNKIRK, OHIO:

SECTION I. Title 3, Chapter 19 of the Ordinances of the Village of Dunkirk, Ohio shall be amended as follows:

Sec. 319.16 Finder’s Fee for Grants.

Any citizen of the Village of Dunkirk, who identifies, applies for, and obtains a grant that would either:

- (a) Improve or maintain the water or sewer system of the Village. Said project must be approved by the Board of Public Affairs prior to application for the grant, or
- (b) Improve, maintain, or construct, Village or public facilities, parks or any other project that would improve the lives of the citizens of the Village of Dunkirk, Ohio. Said project must be approved by the Village Council prior to application for the grant.

Said person or persons shall receive recognition in a monetary value. The value will be as follows:

- (1) The full value allowed by the grant, using grant money for the preparation needed to prepare the paper work required for the filing of the grant. This provision excludes engineer fees for the preparation of construction drawings required to be done by a certified engineer.
- (2) If the grant money is not allowed to be used for filing then the Village will pay 3% of the grant value, up to a maximum of \$1500.00 per grant. This money will come from either the water or sewer fund, whichever is appropriated to the particular grant.
- (3) Elected Village Officials and their immediate family are ineligible for receipt of Finder’s Fees.

SECTION II. All other ordinances in conflict are hereby expressly repealed.
